UPCOMING HIGHWAY WORKS on St Noets Road, Hardwick

Cambridgeshire County Council on behalf of Hardwick Parish Council, in conjunction with appointed contractors, M Group, will be carrying out minor highway improvement works in the vicinity of St Neots Road on week commencing **Monday 26th May untill 6th June 2025**.

The works will include the installation of two pedestrian crossing islands:

- One near the layby by Millers Way
- One near the bus stop close to the roundabout, opposite property number 289

Additionally, minor improvements will be made to the adjacent footways.

To ensure these works are completed safely and efficiently:

- The footpath will be cordoned off
- A road closure will be in place

Access for all residents and businesses will be maintained throughout the works, although this may result in slightly longer travel times.

Please refer to the attached diversion plan for details of the temporary traffic management arrangements.

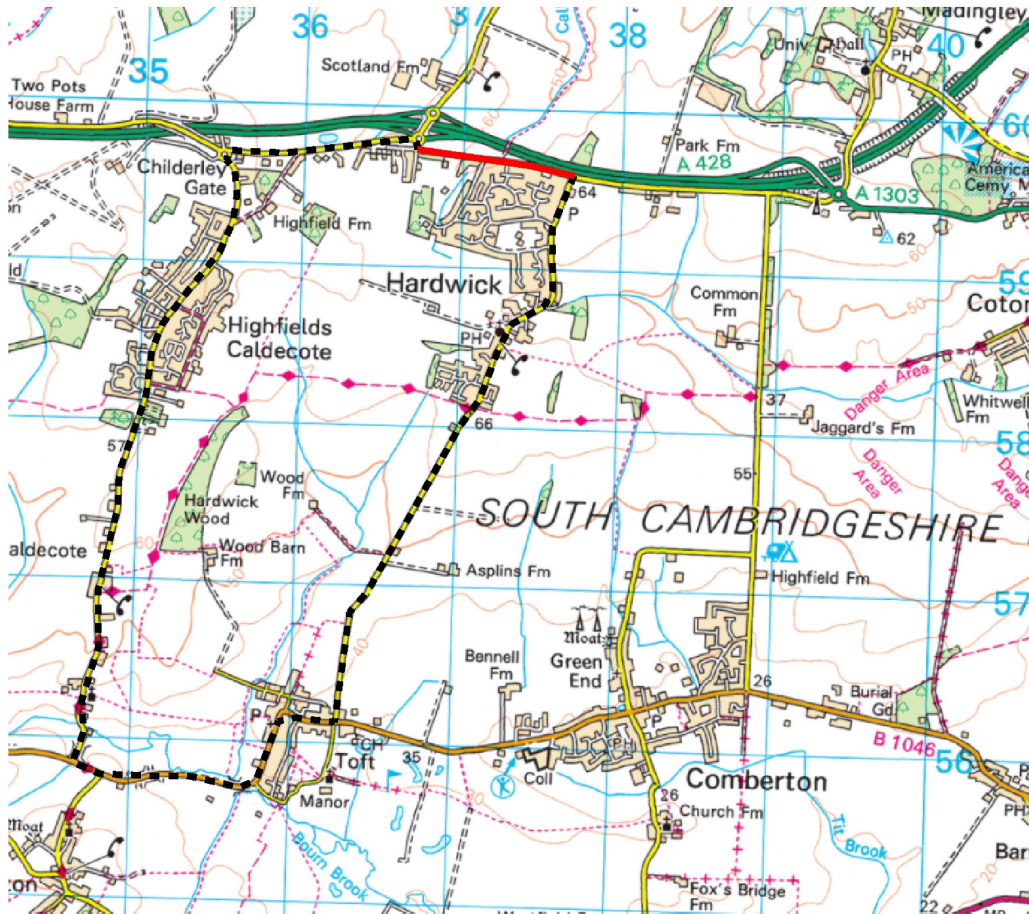
